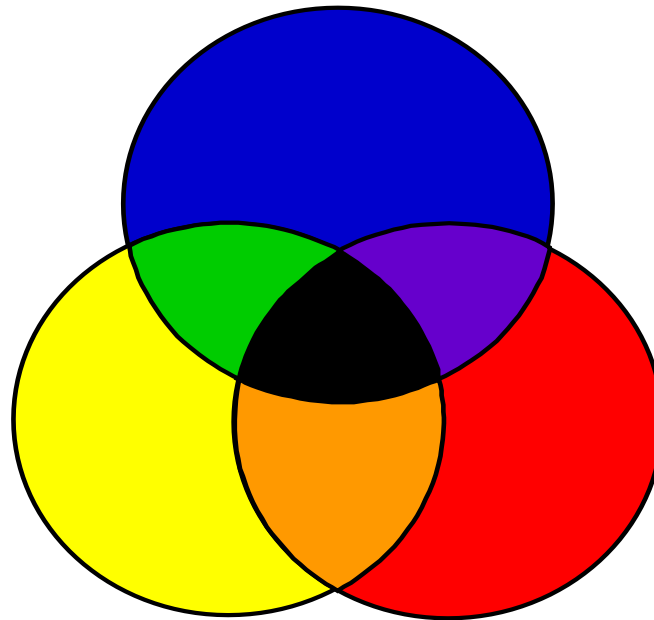

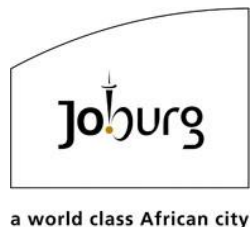




# Objective

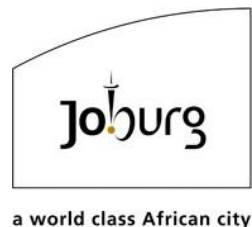

# Objective



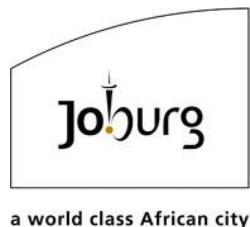

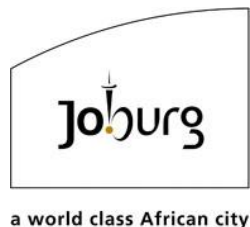


# Objective



Rio de Janeiro has recently implemented a program called **PRO YOUTH**, which is aimed at training in *contact center skills*, the unprivileged youth, between 18 and 29 years of age, and helping them reach their **FIRST JOB**.

The Mayor's office for the City of Rio de Janeiro, through the **Secretary of Economic Development and Secretary of Employment & Labor**, responsible for the project implementation and coordination, formed more than 6000 young people last year and plan to train 7000 in 2011. - **The First**

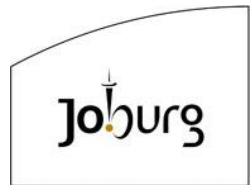
- It would be the first time that a 3-way sister city alliance would take place. Up to now there have only been twins.
